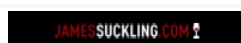

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FERRUCCIO DEIANA ISOLA DEI NURAGHI PLUMINUS 2021

This is an aspirational cuvee, charged with some later harvested/bettry/cappamento fruit of sorts, imparting roasted chestnut, poached apricot and candied peach elements to the fray. Distinctly full-weighted and dry, with a burr of heat across the finish. Oak signposts corral, while directing bold length. An impactful wine that needs food. Drink now.



FERRUCCIO DEIANA ISOLA DEI NURAGHI PLUMINUS 2022

Lemon curd, apricots and vanilla on the nose. Some cedar. It's creamy with a medium to full body and rich vanilla, cream and candied ginger elements, while retaining good acidity to balance. Drink now.
